MCGM to audit 70 British era bridges

Following the Mahad bridge collapse, Trushna Vishwasrao, Sena House leader in the civic body, on Monday wrote to the civic chief Ajay Mehta, citing the audit of dilapidated bridges in the city. The Sena leader has asked Mehta to examine the structural audit of dilapidated bridges in the island city and suburbs and to submit the report to all civic corporators.

Vishwasrao said, "Many lives were lost after the British era bridge collapsed in Mahad. Therefore, the authorities should be more alert about the issue of dilapidated bridges in order to avoid such unfortunate events."

Also, Mehta has already claimed that the civic body will conduct an audit of all the 314 bridges in the island city and the suburbs. According to a senior civic official, "There are over 70 British-era bridges in the city, out of which 41 for vehicular traffic and 30 for pedestrian traffic. The civic chief has ordered for an audit of all bridges."

Earlier in 2014, the Standing Technical Advisory committee, state-appointed committee for the inspections of roads in the city, declared 58 bridges unsafe, out of which 34 are under the jurisdiction of the MCGM. Back then, the civic body had decided that it will outsource the surveying of the bridges, however till date; nothing of this sort has been done.

The Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai had previously repaired few rail over bridges after the railway authorities complained about the condition of the bridges. Moreover, bridges like Hancock and the Carnac Bridge at Sandhurst Road and Masjid Bunder were in bad shape. After a disagreement between the railway authorities and the civic body, the Hancock Bridge was razed on November 2015.

The issue of safety of the bridges has been lately raised by political leaders in the MCGM following the Mahad tragedy where more than 20 people lost their lives after the British-era Bridge on the Mumbai-Goa highway collapsed.

BJP plans several programs to celebrate 70 years of freedom

The BJP has planned several programs to celebrate 70 years of independence throughout the fortnight starting August 9, party's state unit president Raosaheb Patil Danve said.

A special program 'Azadi 70 - Jara Yaad Karo Qurbani' is being organized by the state and the union government and the party workers would organize programs at their respective places to coordinate with the government programs Danve said.

Union minister Venkaiah Naidu and Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis would participate in the biggest function in the

state on On August 9, at "August Kranti Maidan" where the quit India movement initiated in 1942, Danve said. The BJP workers would undertake several programs in next 15 days like tricolour march, candle march, patriotic cultural programs etc, he added.

Meanwhile, a statement released by cultural minister Vindo Tawde said that during the program at August Kranti Maidan on August 9, an e-book on History of 1942 Quit India Movement would be released at the hands of Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis. The book has been published under the gazetteer series on the history of Indian freedom struggle.

Nerul robbery could be an inside job: cops

The Thane Crime branch detained one person for the Rs 6 crore heist at Popular Finance Company in Sector 42 near Shreeji Seva Co-Operative Housing Society at Seawoods in Nerul. The Thane police suspect that the heist conducted at the cash firm is an inside job.

Five people in their late 20s including two women, armed with sickles and firearms barged into the company and stole cash and gold jewellery weighing 23 kilos. The incident took place on Saturday at 3 p.m.

One of the men held a sickle to the cashier's neck and threatened the other staffers to empty the treasury. The five robbers had covered their faces at the time of the heist.

The crime branch sleuths have detained an office staff as he was unable to answer queries. However, the police claimed they have not got vital leads from him. There were no security guards at the firm's office when the robbery took place.

According to Prashant Khaire, DCP, Zone 1, "We sus-

pect that it's an inside job. The robbery has been pre-planned in a detailed manner. We have obtained the CCTV footage at Anand Dairy and Snacks Corner which is 100 metres from Popular Finance's office in Nerul. The five robbers cannot be identified since they had covered their faces with monkey caps before entering the office. The sixth suspect was at the wheels of the Swift Dzire parked outside the office. After he gave them the green signal, the five walked from Anand Dairy and stormed into the office with weapons."

"The gangs also broke the computers in the office and took away the hard disk of the CCTV cameras so that they cannot be traced. We have recorded statements of the manager, cashier, attendant and two women staff. If required we may detain more staff. The matter is under investigation," said the officer.

According to the NRI police, the robbers allegedly escaped via the Mumbai-Pune Expressway. The police have sought CCTV footage of the Khalapur toll plaza. The police have formed six teams to trace the accused.

Turmoil in CR

Central Railway's turmoil continued on Monday which also troubled the suburban railways. A signal system failure near the Vidyaiah station at 10.25am led to disruption in the delay of train schedules by 25 minutes.

Due to the Malfunction, both up and down trains plying between Vidyaiah and CST were affected which led to more trouble for the daily commuters. The locals on the main route gradually restored on its track soon after the signal deterioration was repaired by 11am.

Following the turmoil at the central railway on Monday, A 28 yr old was electrocuted by an overhead wire at the Guru Tekh Bahadur Nagar Station while he was travelling on the rooftop of the train. The name of the deceased is Badaru Yadav, a Sion-Koliwada resident.

The incident occurred around 6.40pm which led to the disruption of the Harbour line for an hour. Yadav was rushed to the civic run Sion Hospital where the doctors declared him dead. The incident has been recorded in Wadala railway police station. Two locals at Panvel and two locals at Vashi were cancelled due to the incident.

61 new colleges get affiliations in state

Sixty-one new colleges have been given affiliations in the state this academic year under different universities.

Of the 61 new colleges, 24 will be affiliated to Mumbai University. Of these, there are eight law colleges spread over Mumbai, Thane, Navi Mumbai, Kharghar and Panvel. There are three night colleges and seven degree colleges. They are in Mumbai, Palghar, Sindhudurg, Thane and Ratnagiri.

Mumbai University had recommended 125 colleges for affiliation to the state government. As per the university's prospective plan, it needed at least 63 new colleges - 13 degree colleges, 11 law, three for B Ed, seven night colleges, six for fine arts, five engineering, six architecture, five pharmacy and seven women's colleges.

Four colleges got affiliation under SNDT Women's University. They are in Pune, Mumbai, Wardha and Yavatmal. SNDT University had sent affiliation proposals of 18 colleges this year.

Meeting the needs of a growing population, need for night colleges due to more students going for jobs while studying, distance between colleges are among reasons to get more colleges on board according to a government resolution (GR) that came on 5 August.

More and more students are passing out of Class XII and hence there is demand for more colleges it said. The GR that announced the list of newly affiliated colleges mentions inequality in educational opportunities in regions like Marathwada and adivasi areas as one of the reasons too. All these colleges have been given affiliations under permanent non-grant status.

One more arrest in Gadoli encounter

The Special Investigation Team (SIT) of the Mumbai crime branch arrested a sixth person; a suspended police constable of the Gurgaon police in connection with the Sandeep Gadoli fake encounter case.

The arrested accused, Deepak Kakran was suspended on May 30 following a probe by the SIT. Kakran has been remanded in custody till August 11.

According to a senior police officer, "We have arrested the accused constable Deepak Kakran in the fake encounter case. He was in touch with Divya (the girlfriend of Sandeep Gadoli) and Sonia Pahuja (Divya's mother). During the probe it has been discovered that vital information regarding Gadoli's location was being passed on to the accused by the duo."

Divya Pahuja, girlfriend of the slain gangster, allegedly stayed with Gadoli and passed on information to her mother, Sonia. Divya who was in the room at the time of the encounter had allegedly tipped off the police about his location. Sonia had passed on the information to Kakran and the four other arrested accused cops - head constable Pramjeet Ahlawat, sub-inspector Pradhyuman Yadav, Vikram Singh and Jitendra Yadav.

Last month, the SIT of the Mumbai crime branch arrested Divya Pahuja, Sonia Pahuja, constables Pramjeet Ahlawat and Vikram



Singh and sub-inspector Pradhyuman Yadav. Manoj Gujjar, Gadoli's rival is presently wanted in the case. Sonia had allegedly tipped off Gadoli's location to him.

As per the CCTV footage, the Haryana police were trying to damage a camera facing Gadoli's room before he was gunned down in a hotel room in Andheri.

Gadoli, a Gurgaon-based gangster, was shot dead by Yadav's team inside Hotel Airport Metro, located near Chhatrapati Shivaji International Airport in Andheri. While the Gurgaon police team claimed they had fired in self-defence, the SIT formed by the Mumbai Police concluded that the encounter was fake and filed an FIR against eight people.

Cases registered under Unlawful Activities Prevention Act

Mumbai: Nagpada Police Station on Monday registered a case under Unlawful Activities Prevention Act against Arshid Qureshi and Rizwan.

According to police, father of Ashfaq Mateen, who had joined Islamic State of Iraq and Syria (ISIS), registered a complaint against Arshid Qureshi and Rizwan Khan who were instigated by Arshid Qureshi to join ISIS.

Arshid Qureshi and Rizwan Khan have already been arrested by Kerala Police in other case. Investigation of the present case is being carried out by Crime Investigation Department, Mumbai Police.

Arshid Qureshi, was arrested in a joint operation by the Kerala Police and Maharashtra ATS, has been remanded to transit remand of the Kerala Police till July 25 here by a Belapur court.

Now PIL on MLA salary hike

Adding to the criticism over the State government's decision to hike the monthly salaries of MLAs, a public interest litigation (PIL) has been filed in the Bombay High Court.

Activist Ketan Tirotkar, has challenged the government's bill, passed on August 5, this year, wherein the government had decided to hike the salaries and pensions of the sitting as well as former MLAs of the State.

Citing the financial burden over the State government, which runs in crores of rupees, the petition states, "The salaries of sitting MLAs were raised to 1.5 lakh to 2 lakh rupees. Also the ministers and ex-MLAs were awarded with heightened pension to match the one drawn by Chief Secretary and other senior IAS of-

ficers."

"Maharashtra's debt burden stood at Rs 3.79 lakh crore as on March 31, 2016, the highest among all the Indian states. The State's salary burden was increased from Rs 22,879 crore in 2007 to Rs 79,941 crore in 2016. The pension payments jumped from Rs 4,682 crore to Rs 24,730 crore in the same period," the petition states.

With reference to the financial burden on the State, Tirotkar has stated that each child born in Maharashtra will have to bear the burden of around Rs 26,000.

The petition has also drawn attention over the 'sorry state' of the pensions and salaries to government employees like Teachers, Lawyers and Policemen etc.

Terming the Bill as 'atrocious' the petition states "The Bill was passed on the floor of the house on the last working day of the mon-

soon session, when otherwise throat-grabbing political rivals struck so much unanimous chord that there was not even a minute's discussion on the Robbers' Bill. This haste and ugly silence/unanimity of 288 members across the party lines proves the means-rea on the part of the State-spon-

sored dacoits."

Tirotkar has sought quashing of the said bill and has also prayed for directions to the government for depositing an amount of Rs 5 crore in State's Legal Aid Society, as a penalty for mooted the atrocious bill.

The PIL is likely to be heard in the next week.

Thane ACB files chargesheet in multicore irrigation scam

In a major relief to senior NCP leaders Ajit Pawar and Sunil Tatkare, the Thane unit of Anti Corruption Bureau (ACB) on Monday filed its chargesheet in the irrigation scam case.

It may be recalled that both Pawar and Tatkare have invited too much criticism after their political rivals and many others leveled allegations about their involve-

ment in the scam.

The 30,000-page charge sheet, ACB has named a total of 10 accused in the case and has levelled several charges against them including Cheating and Forgery. The ACB that is investigating the case since last year, on Monday released its statement saying, "Chargesheet has been filed against irresponsible behaviour regarding Bhalanga project, which was carried by the Jalsampada Vibhag of

Maharashtra State."

However, the agency has also clarified that further investigations in the case are in progress.

With this statement from the agency, a supplementary chargesheet in the case can be expected.

Fateh Mohd Abdul Khatri, Nisaar Fateh Khatri and Abid Fateh Mohd Khatri, the partners of FA Enterprises are named by the ACB in its lengthy chargesheet.

Man held for raping teenager

The Diva police arrested one person in connection with rape of a 17-year-old girl. The incident took place at Sabegaon in Diva (E). The accused has been identified as Nabin VEDI (24).

According to the Diva police, "The accused lured the victim with a job offer. Later, he called the girl to meet him at an isolated spot in Kopri (E). Since the girl was known to the victim, she did not sus-

pect any foul play."

On the way, VEDI spiked the soft drink of the victim; took an autorickshaw and took the victim to a flat in Sabegaon in Diva (E). After sexually assaulting the victim twice, he snatched the SIM-card from her phone so that she could not reach out for any help. Later, the victim came home and narrated the incident to her family.

The family of the victim approached the police and registered a First Informa-

tion Report (FIR). The police procured the Call Detail Records (CDR) of the accused and traced his location to Shirur near Pune.

According to Senior Police Inspector Korde, "A team was formed to nab the accused. We had received a tip off that the accused was going to visit New Garvya hotel at Ghodbunder at Kasarvadavli in Thane (W). VEDI was nabbed from the hotel."

The accused is a resident of Thane.
